Additionally upon arrival, each applicant's temperature will be taken with a non-touch forehead scanner to ensure that he or she does not have a fever.
- The Wonderlic entrance test is waived for applicants applying from 4/9/2020 until 5/18/2020. On campus, in person testing will resume 5/18/2020. Call 417-777-5062 for an appointment. BTC is limiting testing to one applicant per room and sanitizing equipment between each use. In order to enter the building, you will be asked a series of screening questions. Additionally upon arrival, each applicant's temperature will be taken with a non-touch forehead scanner to ensure that he or she does not have a fever.
