In accordance with CDC recommendations effective 6/4/21, Bolivar Technical College will utilize the following guidelines for COVID-19 management. (Centers for Disease Control, 2021)

- 1. Bolivar Technical College recommends vaccination for all students. Students can find a vaccination clinic HERE.
 - a. Vaccination is not mandatory.
 - b. Bolivar Technical College's vaccine policy is driven by the vaccine policies of our clinical partners, the health of our students, and the needs of the communities we serve.

2. All students:

- a. BTC students are encouraged to wash their hands and practice respiratory etiquette.
- b. Students should follow the handbook policies for attending class and clinical if feeling ill.
- c. Students who have questions regarding COVID/ illness policies are encouraged to contact the school

3. Students who are unvaccinated:

- a. Unvaccinated students should mask at all times when indoors or in close contact with other individuals.
- b. Exposure to a person who has COVID-19 should be reported to the school and testing is required within 24 hours of the exposure.
- c. Students who experience symptoms of COVID-19 with no known exposure also require testing within 24 hours.
 - i. Information for testing can be found through the Polk County Health Center.
- d. Students required to quarantine must provide a written quarantine order with name, date, and quarantine start and release dates within 3 business days of positive result and quarantine order.
 - i. This documentation is required for excused absence.
 - ii. Student will continue with distance education.

4. Students who are vaccinated:

- a. Vaccinated students are not required to mask, unless they are ill or have weakened immune systems. Proof of vaccination should be submitted to the front office.
 - i. Students with fever or other symptoms detailed in the policy, are required to follow the handbook policy for illness.

- b. Vaccinated students that are exposed to a person positive for COVID-19 are not required to test or quarantine unless symptoms develop.
 - i. Students should report the exposure and monitor for symptoms for 14 days.
- c. Any student who develops symptoms of COVID-19 (even those vaccinated) are required to test within 24 hours.
- d. Vaccinated students who are required to quarantine based on testing or symptoms, will need to submit a written quarantine order with name, date, and quarantine start and release dates within 3 business days of positive result and quarantine order.
 - i. This documentation is required for excused absence.
- ii. Student will continue with distance education.
